BARBERSHOP ORGANIZATIONS

Barbershop Harmony Society



Founded by O.C. Cash and Rupert Hall in Tulsa, OK in 1938, the Barbershop Harmony Society (BHS) is the first of several organizations to promote and preserve barbershop harmony among singers of all ages. North America is divided into several districts, including the Mid-Atlantic District (MAD) which includes areas of New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania. Voices of Gotham has represented MAD on the international stage 8 times.

Sweet Adelines International



Sweet Adelines International (SAI) was founded in 1945 by Edna Mae Manderson of Tulsa, Oklahoma. The aim was to teach and train women in music and to create and promote barbershop quartets and choruses. Areas throughout the world are divided into several regions, including Region 15, which covers the Greater New York and New Jersey area. Sirens of Gotham is the 2019 3rd Place Region 15 Chorus and recently won 1st place Division A and 1st Place Overall in the 2018 SAI Harmony Classic, an international competition for small barbershop choruses.

OUR PROGRAMS

Arrangers' Lab

The Arrangers' Lab is Voices of Gotham's resident collective of composers who create and arrange new music in the barbershop harmony and contemporary a cappella styles. Already educated in significant university music programs, they apply their skills toward the study of the barbershop tradition and the ongoing development of its repertoire.


In addition to providing Voices of Gotham and its affiliated quartets with custom material, the Arrangers' Lab also leads an ongoing Barbershop Arranging Workshop for members of the chorus at large. In the workshop, participants study existing barbershop arrangements, learn basic theory and composition, and gain insight and feedback on their work.



Tin Pan Alley Novice Quartet Contest

Hosted by Voices of Gotham, Tin Pan Alley is an annual free event open to the public that gives new quartets the chance to compete in front of both an audience and a panel of certified judges from the Barbershop Harmony Society.

TPA fosters choral excellence by encouraging barbershop quartet singing, developing quality singers, educating contestants and spectators on the history of barbershop in New York City, and mobilizing the Arrangers' Lab to produce brand new arrangements. Quartets of all



voicings and levels can participate! Many that begin here go on to compete in formal competitions. Pictured here is half of last year's winner Skittles, a mixed quartet!

The next Tin Pan Alley Quartet Contest will be Saturday, January 25, 2020 at The Belfry, located at 222 East 14th Street!

ABOUT THE ARTISTS





Performing a variety of genres from barbershop, to contemporary pop, to classical, to vocal jazz, Sirens of Gotham takes pride in performing all kinds of a cappella music with precision and heartfelt artistry. The ensemble has accomplished much since its establishment in November 2011, but has grown exponentially since February 2013, when Sirens of Gotham became a chartered chapter of Sweet Adelines International (SAI). Within SAI Region 15, the Sirens have claimed the title of Division A (Small Chorus) Champions three times, and most recently won 3rd place overall, 2nd Place Division AA (Midsize Chorus), and Most Improved Chorus at the 2019 Regional Convention in Albany, NY. In October 2018, they made their international competition debut at the SAI Harmony Classic barbershop chorus competition in St. Louis, MO, where they won 1st place Division A and 1st place overall!

ABOUT THE DIRECTORS

MIRA TAFERNER - Artistic Director, Sirens of Gotham



Mira is a widely successful performance artist and designer with over 15 years of experience in a cappella, barbershop, and dance. Most recently, she served on the Visual and Music Teams for the Harmunichs, a three-time champion of Barbershop in Germany ("BinG!"), and in March 2016, she took home the bronze medal with her quartet Kickstart at the BinG! National Convention. This allowed her to join the Heavy Medal chorus, a mixed barbershop ensemble from Germany consisting of BinG! quartet medalists.

Mira is a recurring faculty member at BinG! Harmony College and has been an ambassador for expansion and celebration of barbershop music in Europe. She is also a talented graphic designer with over 7 years of work experience.

LARRY BOMBACK - Artistic Director, Voices of Gotham



Larry is the founding director of Voices of Gotham, having served in the position from the ensemble's inception in 2008 until 2014, when he moved to Philadelphia to pursue career opportunities and grow his family. He returned in July 2018 in a new role as Artistic Director, where he has been tasked with building and expanding the musical leadership from within our talented ranks.

He currently sings tenor with 'Round Midnight, the 2006 New York Harmony Sweepstakes Champions, 2010 Mid-Atlantic District champions, and 2019 Barbershop Harmony Society international finalist. He previously sang tenor with the 2007 International Collegiate Quartet Champion, Road Trip. In addition to founding

Voices of Gotham, he was instrumental in launching two other choruses: the Sirens of Gotham (SAI) in 2011 and Rittenhouse Sound (BHS) in 2014. In his professional life, Larry is Senior VP of Administration at the world-renowned Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia. Prior to this appointment, he was Chief Operating Officer and Chief Financial Officer at DataArts. He has also served as Director of Finance and Operations at OPERA America and Operations Manager at the New York Youth Symphony. He now lives in Philadelphia with his wife Coren and his two young children, Baylee and Salem.

From Southern California, The Newfangled Four is an internationally-ranked barbershop quartet, most recently placing 6th in the world at the 2019 Barbershop Harmony Society Convention in Salt Lake City. Formed in the fall of 2012 through their involvement with the Westminster Chorus and Masters of Harmony, two well-renowned choruses in the BHS, this foursome combines old-fashioned slapstick humor with their quirky youthful comedy. In 2013, the quartet won the International Collegiate Barbershop Quartet Contest and the Far Western District Quartet Contest. Over the years they have developed a reputation not only for their fine singing and showmanship, but also for their work and involvement in the youth movement as clinicians and educators. The Newfangled Four has appeared on Buzzfeed, Hallmark's "Home and Family show," the new "Gong Show," and has recorded custom tracks for the Lifetime Movie Network. They have millions of views on their YouTube performances and are proud to introduce the barbershop artform to aspiring young singers.
